
The Art-in-Science event is **open to the entire thermal community** and does not need to be related to conference paper submissions.

We invite you to submit your artwork in the following themes related to the conference and thermal and thermo-mechanical phenomena. Alternate themes may also be suggested in the submission form.


- 25th Anniversary of ITherm
